<p><b><u>Masks for Indoor Settings</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ For fully vaccinated children and adults, masks are optional</li> <li>➤ For unvaccinated children and adults, masks are required inside all campus buildings.</li> </ul> <p><b><u>Masks for Outdoor Settings</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ No masks are required</li> </ul>	<p><b><u>Masks for Indoor Settings</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Masks are required for all children and adults</li> </ul> <p><b><u>Masks for Outdoor Settings</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ No masks are required</li> </ul>
<p><b><u>Distancing for Indoor Settings</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ All children are required to maintain a distance of 3-feet from others</li> <li>➤ All adults are required to maintain a minimum distance of 3-feet from children</li> <li>➤ Classrooms are setup with a distance of 3-feet between desks</li> </ul> <p><b><u>Distancing for Outdoor Settings</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Avoid close contact with others</li> </ul>	<p><b><u>Distancing for Indoor Settings</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ All children are required to maintain a distance of 3-feet from other children</li> <li>➤ All adults are required to maintain a minimum distance of 3-feet from children</li> <li>➤ Classrooms are setup with a distance of 3-feet between desks</li> </ul> <p><b><u>Distancing for Outdoor Settings</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Avoid close contact with others</li> </ul>
<p><b><u>Lunch Time</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Those students eating in the Dining Hall will be seated with only 2 students per table while maintaining a distance of 3-feet</li> </ul>	<p><b><u>Lunch Time</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Those students eating in the Dining Hall will be seated with only 2 students per table while maintaining a distance of 3-feet</li> <li>➤ Masks are required when not eating or drinking.</li> <li>➤ Masks are not required for outdoor dining</li> </ul>
<p><b><u>COVID-19 Symptoms Checklist</u></b>            Please notify the school nurse for the following:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. If you or your child are exhibiting symptoms of COVID-19</li> <li>2. If you or your child have been in close contact with an infected person</li> <li>3. If you and your family have travelled internationally</li> </ol> <p>If your child has tested positive for COVID-19:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Parents should notify the School Nurse</li> <li>• All Faculty and Staff should notify their Division Director or Supervisor if anyone has experienced any of the 3 scenarios</li> <li>• Parents, Students, Faculty, and Staff should not return to school until they have been cleared by the School Nurse</li> </ul>	<p><b><u>COVID-19 Symptoms Checklist</u></b>            Please notify the school nurse for the following:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. If you or your child are exhibiting symptoms of COVID-19</li> <li>2. If you or your child have been in close contact with an infected person</li> <li>3. If you and your family have travelled internationally or to another state with high levels of COVID-19</li> </ol> <p>If a your child has tested positive for COVID-19:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Parents should notify the School Nurse if anyone in their immediate family has experienced any of the 3 scenarios listed above</li> <li>• All Faculty and Staff should notify their Division Director or Supervisor if anyone has experienced any of the 3 scenarios</li> <li>• We will contact trace and notify anyone potentially exposed</li> </ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Parents, Students, Faculty, and Staff should not return to school until you have been cleared by a Negative PCR Test and/or a physician's release to return to school/work.</li> </ul>
<p><b><u>Athletics &amp; PE Indoor Settings</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ For all Staff and Students who physically and actively participate, masks are optional</li> <li>➤ Masks are required for those who are not actively participating</li> </ul> <p><b><u>Athletics &amp; PE Outdoor Settings</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Masks are optional</li> </ul>	<p><b><u>Athletics &amp; PE Indoor Settings</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ For all Staff and Students who physically and actively participate, masks are optional</li> <li>➤ Masks are required for those who are not actively participating</li> </ul> <p><b><u>Athletics &amp; PE Outdoor Settings</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Masks are optional</li> <li>➤ Masks are required for those sitting on the bench waiting to play</li> </ul>
<p><b><u>Use of School Provided Transportation</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ All Staff, Adult Chaperones, and Students are required to wear masks in any of the school vehicles provided for transportation</li> <li>➤ No food or drinks inside any of the assigned school vehicles</li> <li>➤ Windows must be open wide enough to create outside air flow into the school's mode of transportation</li> </ul>	<p><b><u>Use of School Provided Transportation</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ All Staff, Adult Chaperones, and Students are required to wear masks in any of the school vehicles provided for transportation.</li> <li>➤ No food or drinks inside any of the assigned school vehicles.</li> <li>➤ Windows must be open wide enough to create outside air flow into the school's mode of transportation</li> </ul>

COVID-19 Quarantine Guidelines	
<p><b><u>Vaccinated</u></b></p> <p>If you or anyone in your immediate household has come in close contact or has been exposed to someone with COVID-19:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Quarantine is not required</li> <li>➤ Masks are required for 10 days from the first day of exposure</li> <li>➤ Closely monitor for any symptoms of COVID-19.</li> <li>➤ It's recommended that you get tested for COVID-19 three to five days from the first day of exposure</li> </ul>	<p><b><u>Unvaccinated</u></b></p> <p>If you or anyone in your immediate household has come in close contact or exposed to someone with COVID-19:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ You are required to quarantine for 10 days from the first day of exposure</li> <li>➤ It's recommended that you get tested for COVID-19 three to five days from the first day of exposure</li> <li>➤ Parents, Students, Faculty, and Staff should not return to school until you have been cleared by a Negative PCR Test</li> </ul>

GUIDELINES FOR RETURNING TO SCHOOL
<p><b><u>Tested for COVID-19</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• If symptomatic and the PCR test results are negative, and your symptoms have improved, you may return to when you are free from fever for 24hrs without the use of fever reducing medication.</li> <li>• If symptomatic and the PCR test results are positive, you must meet the following criteria before returning to school: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Quarantine for 10 days from the first day of onset of symptoms</li> <li>✓ Must be free from fever for 24hrs without the use of fever reducing medications.</li> <li>✓ Symptoms have improved</li> <li>✓ Written documentation from a healthcare provider clearing you or a Negative PCR Test</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
