### QUESTIONS

Adaptive testing generates an individualized digital SAT exam for you. Questions are direct and concise.

ACT questions are complex but direct and concise. You have less time per question to answer than on the SAT.

### MATH

Arithmetic, Algebra 1 & 2, Geometry, Trigonometry, and Data Analysis

Arithmetic, Algebra 1 & 2, Geometry, Trigonometry, and Probability/Statistics

There is one section of Math on both exams. You can use a calculator for the entire section, no accommodation needed.

### READING & WRITING

1 section: Reading & Writing

2 sections: English & Reading  
Optional: Writing (Essay)

Each exam includes questions that test your knowledge of grammar, punctuation, and sentence structure as well as your ability to read closely, use evidence to reason, and synthesize information from a variety of sources.

### ACCOMMODATIONS

**Extended time, audio assistance, small group testing, preferential seating, computer (for essay), and other basic accommodations are available for both tests.**

Mrs. Schexnyder requests accommodations based on your diagnostic testing and WSSA Accommodation Plan. The accommodations you receive at Winston are not guaranteed on testing, as the decision is ultimately up to the testing company's accommodation department.

### TIMING

Examinees who qualify for 50% or 100% extended time will have 1 day to complete the exam.

If approved for "testing over multiple days, examinees with 50% extended time can split the exam over 3-4 days.

Those with audio assistance can split the exam over 3-4 days.
